Grantham

The Location

The development is located within walking distance of the town centre of Grantham, close to the town's many facilities and amenities including the local railway station.

Grantham is a popular market town located on the River Witham. To the north of the town lies the beautiful countryside of the Vale of Belvoir and to the west picturesque agricultural land.

History and Traditions

Grantham is an ancient red brick town with the 281ft high spire of St. Wulframs Church as a dominating feature. There are a number of historic places of interest in the surrounding Lincolnshire countryside, including Belvoir Castle and Belton House. Woolsthorpe Manor, the birthplace of the scientist, Sir Isaac Newton, who was educated in Grantham is an interesting day out. Grantham is also famous for being the birthplace of Lady Margaret Thatcher, Britain's first female Prime Minister.

Amenities

The town is served by a good range of local facilities and amenities including a number of town centre supermarkets, a large shopping precinct and popular markets. It has a number of primary and secondary schools including Kings School for boys and Harlaxton College. It also boasts a number of pubs and restaurants for all tastes, a well equipped leisure centre and bowling alley.

Transport

Grantham benefits from excellent road and rail links and is 25 miles south of the historical city of Lincoln and approximately 100 miles from London. It is a popular choice for commuters working in the East Midlands, with both the A1 and A52 within easy reach and provides links to the surrounding cities of Peterborough, Nottingham and Leicester. There is also a main line railway with a direct link to London.

How to get there

From the A1, exit onto the A52 signposted Grantham. At the 1st roundabout, turn right and follow this road to the end. At the T-Junction turn left into Dysart Road. Follow this road past the shops on the right, and 'Newton's Walk' can be found approx 200 metres on the right hand side.
